There is a good saying: —You are what you eatl. I think it means that we should be aware of what we are eating and choose healthy food only.

There are so many products today with chemical additives and preservatives. My parents try to buy only natural products, which are not genetically-modified. I can't say I'm a picky eater but there are some dishes which I like and those which I don't. For example, I can't stand mushrooms or chicken in food. Seafood is alright but boiled or fried fish is not for me. My favourite food is pizza. My parents sometimes tell me I should live in Italy, because I like all variations of this food, fried, with sauce or without, with bacon, with cheese, with vegetables, etc.

My most favourite dish is Carbonara. It's a pasta-based dish with white sauce, bacon and parmesan cheese. I can eat it three times a day and never get bored. It's not difficult to cook. You just need half a kilo spaghetti, several slices of bacon, 2 onions, 2 garlic cloves, some olive oil, 1 or 2 eggs, a pinch of salt and pepper, some grated Parmesan cheese and 3 tablespoons of chopped fresh parsley. Spaghetti needs to be boiled in salted water, then drained well and tossed with a tablespoon of olive oil. For the sauce we need to cook chopped bacon on a large pan until it's slightly crispy. Then we add chopped onion and minced garlic clove, 1 tablespoon of olive oil and cook it for a minute. Then we add beaten eggs into the pan, some cheese, salt and pepper and cook it constantly tossing. When the sauce is ready it's added to spaghetti. The dish is sprinkled with chopped parsley and additional cheese. It is served immediately, while it's hot. I have tried to cook Carbonara according to this recipe and it came out to be rather tasty.

One of his famous paintings is even called —Light and Colourl. All his works are highly praised by critics. Turner died in London in 1851. His paintings are considered to be the property of the British nation. Among Russian artists I especially admire Ilya Repin and Valentin Serov. They are both considered to be outstanding Russian masters of art. Ilya Repin was mostly interested in historical and political events of his motherland, which he expressed in the paintings. He created the portraits of some outstanding figures, among them Tolstoy, Mussorgsky, Pirogov. Valentin Serov also painted some famous people, including Nikolai Rimsky-Korsakov, Isaac

Levitan, Sawa Mamontov. His most famous works —The Girl with Peachesl and —The Girl in the Sunlightl can be seen in the Tretyakov Gallery.

Burns worked with his father and brothers. The death of his father in 1784 left Burns free to choose his own kind of life, but it also gave him new responsibilities as the head of the family. As a farmer he was unsuccessful and moved to other place - Burns published his poems in Kilmarnock in 1786. The success was great. Burns wrote many poems and songs. After a short illness he died on 21st of July, 1796. Millions of people all over the world highly esteem and love Burns' poems. S. Marshak, a great soviet poet, brought Burns to Russian people throughout his fine translations.

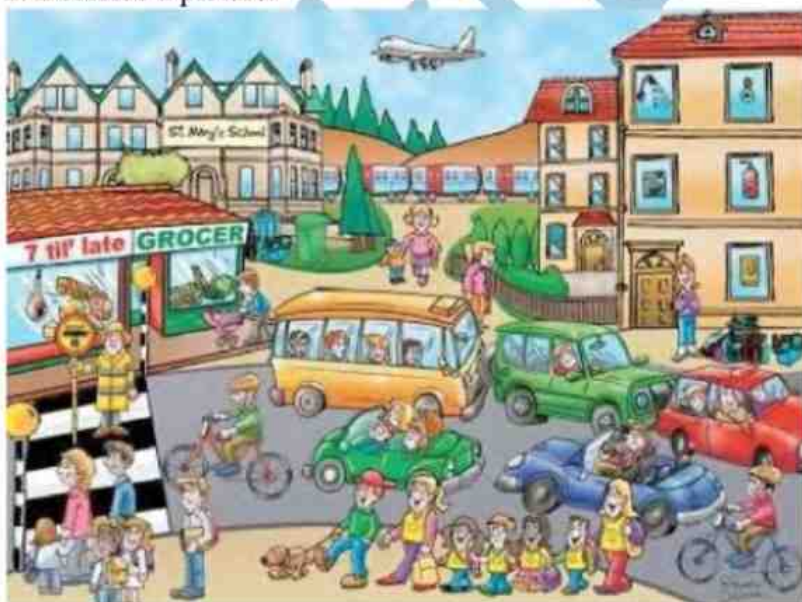

Customs and traditions of the Uzbek people have been forming for centuries. They are very distinctive, impressive and different, dating back to different epochs and religions. Initial formation of Uzbek culture dates back to the 6th-7th centuries BC, by that time nomadic tribes shifted to a settled way of life in the valleys of Amu Darya, Syr Darya and Zarafshan and founded first states. Former nomads founded settlements and cities, bringing with them customs and traditions based on ancient cults of their ancestors. Territory of modern Uzbekistan, Transoxiana, being parts of ancient states – Khorezm, Sogdiana, Bactria - became the basis for formation of culture, which subsequently became the basis of Uzbek culture.

Over centuries, traditions and customs of Uzbek people remained almost unchanged despite the desire of many invaders to impose alien culture on. The Arabs had the greatest influence on Uzbek customs and

traditions, through the expansion of Islam throughout Central Asia. Islam traditions were closely intertwined with pre-Islamic beliefs and traditions, local culture, and firmly settled in the mode and minds of the Uzbek people.

Centuries-old customs and traditions of the Uzbek people are carefully maintained and passed on from generation to generation. Like many Asian nations, most festive Uzbek customs are related with major family celebrations: wedding and birth. These events include many rites and rituals, involving parents, children, brothers, sisters, immediate and remote relatives even neighbors and guests, each one has its own role. Uzbek traditions are based on hospitality, respect for elders, collectivism, manifested especially vividly in makhallas (Uzbek residential quarters) – repository of age-old national basis.

Among other popular celebrations are Christmas and New Year. In London, lots of people go to Trafalgar Square on New Year's Eve. There is singing and dancing at 12 o'clock on December 31st. A popular annual Scottish event is the Edinburgh Festival of music and drama. A truly Welsh event is the Eisteddfod, a national festival of traditional poetry and music, with a competition for the best new poem in Welsh.

I especially like his series of violin concertos known as —The Four Seasons. Vivaldi was born on March 4th 1678, in Venice. He was quickly baptized due to his poor health. He had five other siblings. His father, Giovanni Battista, taught him to play the violin at the very young age. Afterwards, they toured Venice together playing music for people. By the age of 24 Antonio had the extensive knowledge of music. He then started teaching it and soon he presented his first performance for the French Embassy. At the same period he started conducting the orchestra and staging numerous concerts. In 1725 he published a cycle of compositions called —The Contest between Harmony and Invention. His —Four Seasons were also included in this cycle. His music then was full of drama. In fact, Vivaldi made great contributions in the field of ensemble and orchestral music. His violin-based works were marked by virtuosity. The complete collection of these works was published only in the 20th century. The political situation in Europe was rather harsh at the first half of the 18th century and it influenced Vivaldi's work. In 1740 he arrived in Vienna, where he wrote several other compositions, but they were not marked as popular. He died in July of the next year, forgotten and sick. However, his work —Four Seasons became a significant contribution in the development of instrumental music. This melody will keep the memory of the great composer for a long time.
